Purpose of the Position: The Residential Support Worker is part of the multidisciplinary COAST team and is responsible for providing in-home support to residents within a semi-independent congregate living environment. Residential Support Workers facilitate recovery and improved quality of life in a professionally and culturally appropriate manner. Residential Support Workers help residents address needs associated with mental illness, addictions, physical health, and life skills as residents learn and apply skills necessary to facilitate recovery, improvement quality of life and like skills needed to maintain affordable and sustainable housing
